### Virtual Seminar “Deepening the understanding of EU sanctions and enhancing cooperation to reduce sanctions circumvention” on 1 July 2025

The European Union is organizing a full-day virtual training seminar on EU sanctions, scheduled to take place online at 10:30-18:00, Tuesday, 1 July 2025 (Taipei time).

The primary aim of the seminar is to raise awareness of EU sanctions and their application, and to cooperate to counter possible circumvention of these measures.

The EU team of trainers is composed of sanctions experts from the European Commission, representatives from EU Member States as well as experts from the EU private sector (compliance divisions of major banks, exports and transportation/logistics companies).
